

# Getting started with the Digital Library

## Why do I need a library card to access the eBooks?

We license our digital content from a number of companies (library vendors). The vendors require us to only allow our customers to access their products. For most products we are only licensed for the citizens of Colchester-East Hants. Your library card confirms your identity for the library vendor’s websites.

## What devices can be used to read eBooks?

Tablets, smartphones and eReaders can all be used to download and read eBooks. Devices using Android, Windows and iOS operating systems are all compatible and among the most commonly used. Blackberry devices no longer support CEHPL eBook downloads.
